

In O'Connell Primary we are also fortunate to have access to our local **Multi Disciplinary Team (MDT)** based in Summerhill Primary Care centre. We have access to an **educational psychologist, speech and language therapist** and **occupational therapist** who are based in the school two days a week working with staff in supporting students throughout our school.

Rules of the Classroom



1. Be in uniform, be on time and be ready for school.
2. Do as you are asked, follow instructions straight away.
3. Work quietly, finish your work and do it well.
4. Keep unhelpful hands, feet, objects and comments to yourself.
5. Raise your hand and wait for permission to speak or move from your seat.
6. Wait until the correct time to sort out problems.



These are the rules we follow as part of our DFL (Discipline For Learning). Boys who work hard and follow the rules get lots of nice treats and rewards. If you hear your son talking about stages it means he has not followed some of the rules. Boys are given 2 chances before being asked to choose a stage. Discuss these rules with him and help him understand the importance of following the rules of the school. **You as a parent have a very important part to play in your sons education.**



Here in O'Connell Primary we use **classdojo** so you can monitor how your son is doing in school.

Messages and videos are sent out regularly from the principal and from your sons teacher. It is **very important that you download the classdojo app** and enter your sons code so you can access his class. You will only see information relating to your son. You will also be able to message your sons teacher or the school principal with any questions you may have about your son.


